



CHANGES TO ROUTE 182 AND INTRODUCTION OF NEW ROUTE 258

STARTING OCTOBER 30

To give services to passengers less affected by traffic congestion delays the long route 182 from Wembley to Watford Junction is to be replaced by two shorter routes from October 30. The 182 route will then run daily between Wembley and Harrow-on-the Hill Station or Harrow Weald Garage, and a new route 258 will run on weekdays only between Harrow-on-the-Hill Station and Watford Junction. There will be no Sunday bus service along Brookshill and Common Road between Harrow Weald and Bushey Heath.

Exact fares, please

One-man 46 or 50 seat buses will be used on these routes, as they are on route 182 now. There is no conductor, so the driver collects fares and issues tickets as you board. **Please have the exact fare ready. This will save time and help to get the bus moving quickly.**

SERVICE FREQUENCIES

Route 182—WEMBLEY — HARROW WEALD

Mondays to Fridays 10 minutes (17/18 minutes evenings) between Wembley (Empire Pool) and Harrow-on-the-Hill Station, alternate buses running on to Harrow Weald Garage.

As now some peak hour buses will run to and from Wembley Trading Estate.

Saturdays

10 minutes during shopping hours (15 minutes mornings and evenings) between Wembley (Empire Pool) and Harrow-on-the-Hill, alternate buses running on to Harrow Weald Garage.

Sundays

15 minutes (35 minutes early morning), all buses running through from Wembley to Harrow Weald.

Route 258—HARROW-ON-THE-HILL STATION — WATFORD JUNCTION (Weekdays only)

Mondays to Fridays 35 minutes.

Saturdays

27/28 minutes during shopping hours, 35 minutes early morning and evening.
